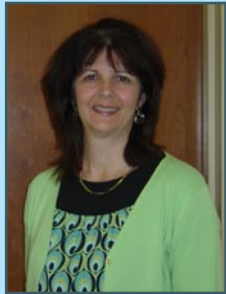
Omni House Welcomes New Board Members

Financial Report

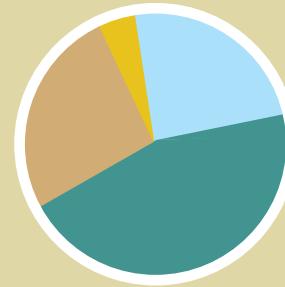
The recession did not impact us significantly until the beginning of fiscal 2009. We have seen authorization for service get squeezed, eligibility rigorously scrutinized, and we expect the loss of some state grant money. Through it all, we have maintained a stable work force (almost two thirds have stayed with us over a year and a half), and a steady cash flow.

We do not know what the rest of this year will bring, but we expect great financial challenges from the state. We anticipate budget cuts of anywhere from 5% to 10%. This will obviously force us to re-engineer how we do business, and unfortunately we would be forced to reduce our staffing patterns. We continue to look for other ways we can reduce costs; for example, by renegotiating health insurance for employees and our property and liability insurance, we saved about \$60,000 in the last year.

Nevertheless, we expect that we can maintain high quality service to our clients and look forward to your support to help fill the gaps. As long as we remain committed to our mission, we can weather the storm and be in a good position when the economy revives.

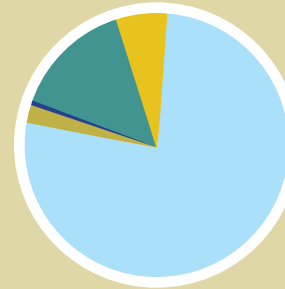
